

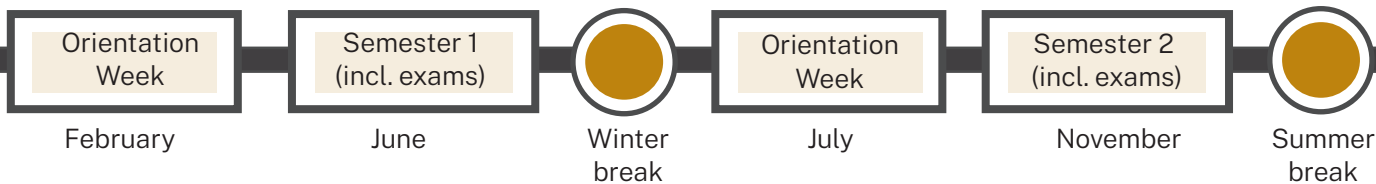

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Students must hold a current visa which entitles them to study for the duration of their program. Typically this is a subclass 500 student visa. Students should apply for a student visa as soon as they receive their electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE) to avoid delays. All visas are subject to conditions and students must ensure they comply with the conditions of their visa at all times.

LIVING EXPENSES

The estimated average cost of living in Canberra is AU\$501-\$784 per week (dependent on residence and room type). This typically covers accommodation, food, utilities and entertainment.
