LIVING IN BARBADOS: About the Island

CAPITAL: Bridgetown

NAME: The name 'Barbados' is derived from the Bearded Fig Trees once found in abundance on the island.

POPULATION: Approximately 285,000

CLIMATE: Eight to nine hours of sunshine most days.

GEOGRAPHY: A 21 mile x 14 mile Caribbean island. West and South Coast have calm Caribbean sea and endless beaches. Rugged

cliffs and Atlantic Ocean on the East Coast.

LANGUAGE: English with a broad dialect.

CURRENCY: Barbados Dollar - US \$1 = BDS \$2 approx.

TIME: GMT-4 hrs. There is no daylight saving time in Barbados

THE PEOPLE: Barbadians have a history of long ingrained Christian principles, a sound educational system with a literacy rate of 97%.

ELECTRICAL SUPPLY: Electricity in Barbados is 110 volts/50 cycles. Standard plug types are: Flat blade (2 flat blades) or Flat blades with round grounding pin

Examinations are residential and you are required to write examinations at The UWI, Cave Hill Campus.


