


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Student Exchange New Calendar, New Opportunities.

Starting in 2019, UNSW Sydney will transition to a new academic calendar titled UNSW3+. Comprised of three terms plus a January intensive term, UNSW3+ is designed to better align with our global partners, eliminating overlap with the Northern Hemisphere summer and creating new opportunities for career and internshipminded students.

Number of Courses

Aligning with the university's new academic calendar, and pending final CRICOS registration, UNSW Student Exchange has crafted new mobility pathways for Exchange students. As this exciting transition approaches, we are thrilled to provide an overview of the changes and the study options available to students.



With a full time academic load remaining at 8 courses per year, students will have the option of electing to take 3 courses during a regular student exchange term or 4 courses during a student exchange tailored term.

Multiple study options are available under UNSW3+ to accommodate diverse student needs. Explore below the pathways available to students, crafted to meet their varied academic needs and institutional requirements.

Term 1 (February-May)

Students enrol in a full load of 3 courses (18 UOC).

Tailored Term 1 (January-May)

January intensive course + Term 1

Students enrol in 4 courses (24 UOC), taking an intensive course in January followed by a full academic load of 3 courses in Term 1.

Term 1 + Term 2 (February - August)

Students enrol in 4 courses (24UOC), taking two courses in each term

Term 3 (September-December)

Students enrol in a full load of 3 courses (18 UOC).

Tailored Term 3 (August-December)

August intensive course + Term 3

Students enrol in 4 courses (24 UOC), taking an intensive course in August followed by a full academic load of 3 courses in Term 3.

UOC denotes units of credit

Term 3 + January Term (September - February)

Students enrol in 4 courses (24UoC), taking a full academic load of three courses in Term 3 followed by an intensive course in January.

Term 1 (Full Year)

Term 1 + Term 2 + Term 3 OR Tailored Term 1 + Tailored Term 3 Students electing to study for a full academic year at UNSW can enrol in 8 courses (48 UOC) either spread over Terms 1, 2 and 3, or spread over Tailored Terms 1 and 3.

Term 3 (Full Year)

Term 3 + Term 1 + Term 2 OR Tailored Term 3 + Tailored Term 1 Students electing to study for a full academic year at UNSW can enrol in 8 courses (48 UOC) either spread over Terms 3, 1 and 2, or spread over Tailored Terms 3 and 1.

Social and Cultural Activities

With a stunning coastline and world-class beaches nestled right within a vibrant, cosmopolitan city, Sydney offers a great deal to students beyond the classroom walls.

UNSW has over 300 clubs and societies for students to choose from, ranging from sports to social events, which provide an excellent campus experience.



Progress Towards 2020

UNSW Student Exchange and the university's academic faculties are working together closely to build upon the first year of UNSW3+ and broaden the excellent curricular opportunities for student exchange students. New and innovative courses are in the works for the 2020 Tailored Term intensive periods, with a focus on cultivating courses which provide:



Australian Focus

Cultural courses across faculties that offer the best of Sydney, from heritage, literature, and the natural environment.



Experiential Learning

Courses designed to immerse students in practical, hands-on learning environments, with a focus on project courses.



Flexibility

A selection of courses that fit across the term to meet subject requirements.
