Bursaries cover the cost of the program registration, but do not include and funding for travel, personal expense or other unrelated costs. This bursary will cover the full cost for one of the following courses:

- July 16 - 20: QSEA Course C or Course D
- July 23 - 27: QSEA Course A or Course B
- July 30 - Aug 3: QSEA Course C or Course D
- Aug 13 - Aug 17: QSEA Course A or Course B

To be eligible for this bursary, all applicants must submit the following additional documentation:

- Proof of Indigenous ancestry (First Nations status card, Metis citizenship card, or letter of community card)
- Proof of registration in high school science courses
- Personal statement from the student detailing why they are interested in the QSEA program or engineering.
